Tyson was born and raised in New York City, earning his BA in Physics from Harvard University and his Ph.D. in Astrophysics from Columbia University. Tyson's professional research interests are broad, but include star formation, exploding stars, dwarf galaxies and the structure of our Milky Way. Tyson obtains his data from the Hubble Space Telescope as well as from telescopes in California, New Mexico, Arizona, and in the Andes Mountains of Chile.
